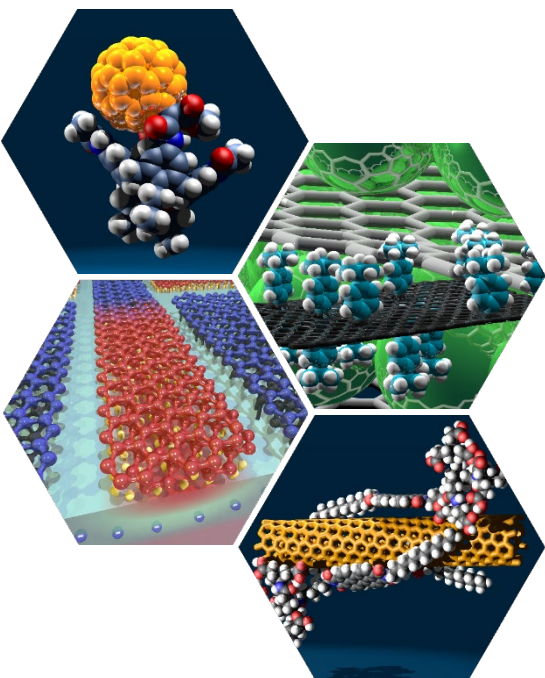


Workshop: Making Science Visible
